SCHOLARSHIP YEAR 2026

Malaysian Diabetes Educators Society (MDES) invites applications for the MDES Scholarship to pursue **Advance Diploma/ Postgraduate Diploma/ Master Study** related to Diabetes Management and Education.

A) Intention

The scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to members of MDES to undertake further professional development within the field of diabetes management and education.

B) RELEVANT DEFINITIONS

In the context of this document:

Scholarship means an award to provide financial assistance to members of MDES to pursue Advance Diploma/ Postgraduate Diploma/ Master Study Training related to Diabetes Management and Education.

Scholarship Panel means a panel who interview candidates to determine scholarship recipients, generally comprising of 3 MDES committee members.

Terms and Conditions means the standards or selection criteria use by the selection committee/panel to rank applicants and select award recipients.

C) Eligibility and Selection Criteria

Terms and Condition

The scholarship is open to:

1. MDES **Members or New Members** who have **completed at least 6 months membership** from the date of application and **Malaysian citizen ONLY**.
2. MDES members who have been awarded similar scholarship in the past are NOT eligible to apply
3. MDES members who have not been awarded a scholarship/grant from **any** organization for this study of Advance Diploma/ Postgraduate Diploma/ Master Study Training.
4. The one-off MDES educational grant of **RM 5000** is to be used for the enrolled Advance Diploma/ Postgraduate Diploma/ Master Study Training **ONLY**.
5. Applications will be made in writing to MDES giving :

- a. **Previous contributions** towards the activities of MDES, or diabetes related community services (Max 250 words)
 - b. Your proposed contributions towards MDES or diabetes related community services **AFTER** completion of your training programme (max 250 words)
 - c. Details of previous grants received from MDES.
6. Incomplete forms will be **REJECTED**
7. Recipients must **remain MDES members and actively contribute to the society** (e.g., through volunteer activities or event participation) for a defined period (e.g., 3-5 years) after receiving the scholarship. Failure to do so may result in revocation of the scholarship or a requirement to refund a portion of the amount.
8. Termination of scholarship
- a. Applicants who withdraws from the course of study, or has been terminated from their studies will be required to repay to Malaysian Diabetes Educators Society the grant awarded (RM 5000) plus an additional 10% of the grant as penalty.
 - b. MDES reserves the right not to award any Scholarships or Sponsorship / Travel Grant in the following 2 years.
9. Completion of Advance Diploma/ Postgraduate Diploma/ Master Study course
- a. Applicants are required to submit to MDES certificate or document of completion of course from the College/University.

D) Documents

The applicant must enclose the following certified copies with the application form:

- a) MyKad (front and back)
- b) Course/Programme official brochure/flyer
- c) Proof of Course/Programme Registration or admission letter
- d) A letter from the head of programme on expected date of course completion
- e) Proof of payment for the Processing Fee

E) Processing Fee

F) Scholarship Disbursement

The education grant will be deposited into successful applicants' bank account after the proof of payment for the Advance Diploma/ Postgraduate Diploma/ Master Study Training enrolled is received.

G) Opening and Closing date of application

The scholarship is open for application on **25.01.2026** and the closing date is on **28.02.2026 23:59 hours**. Application forms received after **the hours** will be rejected.
